It is the most important cultural center in Latin America and is even considered one of the 10 most important museums in the world.

For more than 51 years, the National Museum of Anthropology has provided

the opportunity for millions of visitors to travel in time and in the territorial space of Mexico to know the reaches of the civilizations that populated it, its artistic creations, its technological achievements and its Contributions to universal knowledge.

The National Museum of Anthropology was inaugurated the 17 of September of 1964 by the then president Adolfo López Mateos; The design and the direction of its construction was due to the creativity of the architect Pedro Ramírez Vázquez, who created a work that was considered the proposal of the most advanced architecture of museums of his time and today is located between the classic museums.

offerings. This magnificent set of goldsmiths is one of the richest and most important not only of our country but also of the world.

The Hall of Cultures of the Gulf shows the cultural and artistic diversity of the Olmecs, the inhabitants of downtown Veracruz and the Huastecos, through wonderful jade carved objects, monumental sculptures - among them the enormous Olmec heads - and complicated Figures and containers modeled in ceramic.

The sequence of the Preclassic, Teotihuacan, Tolteca and Mexica halls that occupy the north wing and bottom of the building recreates the cultural, political and artistic evolution that took place in central Mexico for more than thirty centuries, and Explain how the pre-Hispanic societies were transformed from groups of farmers who inhabited villages and rancherías in powerful militaristic states that integrated empires of great power, like the one of the Mexicas, that bequeathed to us the most impressive set of monumental sculptures, among which the Coatlicue and the Stone of the Sun.

The Oaxaca Room is distinguished by its impressive collection of polychrome ceramics, and particularly by the attractive and valuable gold jewelry of ingenious designs and techniques that were deposited as funeral

Monastery Regina Coelli,

“Convento de Santa Lucía de las Convertidas”, which supposedly gave rise to the Monastery of Regina Coelli, located in the middle of cigars and canals, in the then southern part of Mexico City. Sisters of the Conception founded in 1753 the Convent of Regina adjacent to the Regina Coelli Church.

Its baroque architecture alludes to the monarchical sobriety of the inmates, even though the altarpieces and canvases of its chapel became the most praised of its time. In 1863, because of the Reform Laws, the nuns were cloistered and their property expropriated, but they were reinstalled during the empire of Maximilian.
